UKAMHS HOYS Qualifiers: Open to purebred American Miniatures under 34” that have been nominated with the UKAMHS for the 2026 show season, rules and regulations can be found at www.ukamhs.co.uk/hoys.

Open Classes: Open to all miniature horses and ponies under 44” in height.

Youth Classes: Open to all miniature horses and ponies under 44” in height. Youth are only allowed to show mares or geldings.

Performance Classes: Open to all miniature horses and ponies under 44” in height.

Show Rules for the AMHA Approved Section:

These classes are affiliated and run under the rules of the American Miniature Horse Association. A copy of the rules can be obtained from the AMHA website www.amha.org.

Entries: All horses must be registered with the AMHA excluding non-rated classes.
Stallions: Owners of stallions 3 years and over must present a copy of their certificate of Veterinary Inspection for Cryptorchidism to show management prior to participation.
Health Requirements Owners are responsible for knowing and meeting any health requirements regarding the exhibition of the horses and their transport between their home location and the show. Please check with your local veterinarian if you are unsure of the current requirements.
Amateur and youth exhibitors: Must provide a copy of their current amateur or youth cards. Applications for Amateur or Youth memberships will be available at the show office.
Measuring: All horses must be measured prior to participating in their class. Measuring area will be in the main barn. Saturday: 7:30 to 8:30am <ul style="list-style-type: none">- For identification the horse's registration paper, or copy must be presented at measuring, together with its passport.- If you cannot meet these times, please contact the show manager.- Once your horse has been measured you will receive your exhibitor's pack.
Age Heights: Weanlings cannot exceed 30 inches. Yearling cannot exceed 32 inches. Two-Year-Olds cannot exceed 33 inches. Three year of age and older cannot exceed 34 inches.
Conduct: Cruelty, abuse, or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, or stalls, or on the showground is strictly prohibited. The use of stimulants or depressants, or any drug affecting the showing of the horse is forbidden. UKAMHS code of conduct of its members should be adhered to at all times
Responsibility: UKAMHS and show management cannot be held responsible for any accidents, damages, or loss to personal property or livestock.
PA System: It is the owners/handlers/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to the barn area are a management courtesy.
Awards: Ribbons 1 st -6 th place Neck Sash - Grand Champion, Reserve Champion and Supreme

Exhibitors, owners, and handlers must be current members of the UKAMHS. All competitors must have filled out a showing declaration form and paid the appropriate UKAMHS 2025 Showing Levy Fee, www.ukamhs.com.

All exhibits must have been measured at an approved UKAMHS measuring session prior to competing in a qualifier. **Measuring will be available**

Three year of age and older cannot exceed 34 inches

Championship

1st & 2nd place winners from classes come forward to compete in the Championship.

A horse is only allowed to participate in one HOYS Qualifying class per show. For instance, if you decide to enter the stock class, you cannot also enter the corresponding age and sex class, and vice versa.

For the Ultra Mini class mature horses (over three years) cannot exceed 30 inches in height, two-year-olds cannot exceed 29 inches and yearlings cannot exceed 28 inches in height.

The qualifying horse will be the highest placed, previously unqualified, exhibit within the Championship. The Championship is only open to the first and second prize winners from classes 58-65. Exhibits in the championship will be placed to 6th, qualification will not go lower than 6th.

This class will be run in accordance with the UK American Miniature Horse Society, however the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook will take precedence, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk. This is a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier, all data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. The championship is a qualifying class for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, October 2026. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.

Exhibitors are required by DEFRA to carry with them Official Identity Documents for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a DEFRA requirement that the Official Identity Documents must be in the name of the legal owner within 30 days of ownership. This must be registered with the breed society, relevant studbook or ID issuing agency, dependant on breed/type of animal. Spot checks may be carried out at qualifying shows and by breed societies.
