

UKAMHS Showing Declaration 2026

To participate in the UK AMHS American miniature horse HOYS qualifiers, all horses, owners and handlers must be declared for the 2026 show season before entering and competing in the qualifiers. All owners and handlers must be current members. Please ensure that your declarations are submitted on time to guarantee you eligibility for these events.

Owners and exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that their horse(s) are measured on specified measuring days, with dates to be confirmed shortly. Should you pay your showing levies, and your horse does not meet the measurement requirements, the levy for that horse will be refunded. UKAMHS has the right to remeasure any levied horse.

Showing Levy Charges for 2025

Horse Nomination £100

Owner/Handler fee £25

Additional Handler £75

All owners are required to pay showing levy fees for the current year whether you're competing yourself or are having a trainer represent you. If multiple owners wish to showcase their horses, each must contribute with their own owner/handler levy fee.

If you own and handler your own horse, the fees will be as follows:

Horse nomination £100 + Owner/Handler fee £25 = £125.00

If your horse is handled by someone else the fees will be as follows:

Horse nomination £100 + Owner/Handler fee £25 + Additional Handler fee £75 = £200.00

Please note that this showing declaration is specifically for those intending to enter the UKAMHS Horse of the Year Show (HOYS) Qualifiers. You do not need to complete this declaration to participate in the AMHA Approved classes at the UK AMHA Regional Show or in the AMHA Approved and open classes at the UKAMHS British Open Show.
